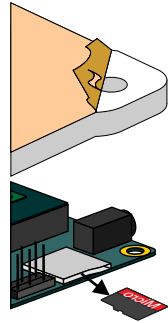

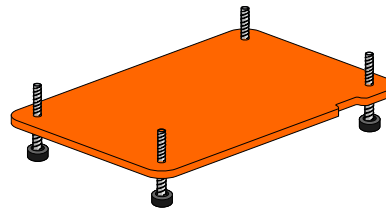
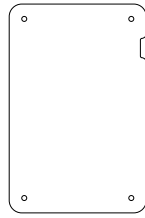
1) Peel Paper off each part.

*Optionally wet paper with warm water to make it easier to peel

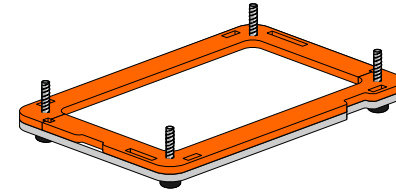
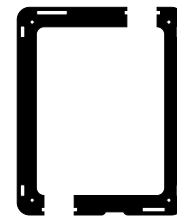
Remove micro SD card from Pine 64 before assembly




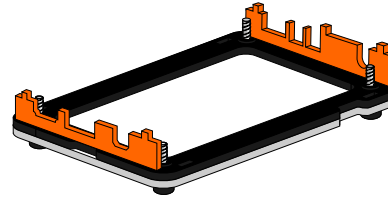

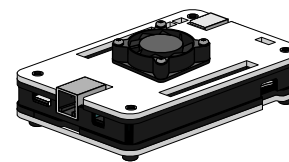
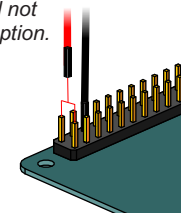
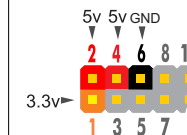


11) Fan upgrade kit

Red wire can be attached to pin 2 and 4 for 5v fan or pin 1 (3.3v) for a slower spin.

Note: some fans will not work with the 3.3v option.
